PARDON

FORGIVENESS AND RELEASE

Pardon is forgiveness of an offense. It provides the offender with release from penalty; it provides the one granting pardon with release from bitterness. In effect, pardon is “letting go.” Pardon removes the drive for revenge, and even the need to completely understand why an offense was committed. Pardon opens the way for reconciliation. To reconcile is to *restore a relationship*.
